



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who can attend Ivy League & Friends?

Choctaw students who are members of the Scholarship Advisement Program and their parents/family are invited to attend. High school counselors, teachers, administrators, and Tribal education officials are also welcome to attend Ivy League & Friends.

How do I register?

In order to attend, you must pre-register on the sign-up/registration section of the Ivy League & Friends updates on the SAP's website.

What should I wear?

Dress business casual. For girls, this includes: dress pants, skirts, dresses, dressy tops. For boys, this includes: slacks, polo shirts, dress shirts. Suits are not necessary. DO NOT WEAR JEANS, DENIM, SWEATSHIRTS, HOODIES, T-SHIRTS, OR HATS.

What should I bring to Ivy League & Friends?

Bring a portfolio. A complete portfolio includes the following important items: Resume, Native American Activities (included in resume), National Admission Test Scores, Transcripts, and Extracurricular Activities (included in resume).

Will SAP provide meals?

Breakfast & lunch will be provided.
